ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS RAISED PANEL GARAGE DOOR KIT



PREPARATION

NOTE: Kits come in sets of four and arrive pre-assembled and pre-primed, ready for installation.

PREP: Start by cleaning your door well with soap and water. Be sure to rinse the door thoroughly to remove residue and leave the door to dry completely before proceeding. If you are working with a new garage door, mount your kit before hanging the door. Be aware that you should not raise and lower your garage door until the adhesive has dried.

PRE-ASSEMBLY: Based on the number of kits purchased, determine your design. While there are many design options, you may wish to use one

kit to apply to one row or column of panels, multiple kits to apply to all panels or



anything in between. (Figures 3-6.) Using the additional assembly instructions specific to your kit style, use a pencil and ruler or measuring tape to mark the outline of your pattern. Pre-marking the design on your garage door will allow you to mount each piece quickly and easily. (Figure 1.)

METHOD OF ASSEMBLY

ATTACH: Working with your garage door down; start with one of the panels of your door where you wish to install your kit. You will need some tape on hand for this phase of installation. Using the included adhesive,



run a zig-zag of adhesive on the back of your first piece. Following your guidelines, press the piece to your garage door. Secure it temporarily using tape to support the piece firmly against the door. (Figure 2.) Make sure to follow the manufacturer's requirements for temperature and cure time to ensure a good bond.

OPTIONAL: If your door has a solid core, you may wish to supplement the adhesive with nails. Pre-drill holes for your nails to avoid splitting and fasten the moldings at least 1/2" from the edge of the product.



FINISHING YOUR KIT

FINISH: Each kit comes pre-primed with a latex primer. For final paint, use a high quality, exterior latex paint. We recommend Sherwin-Williams Emerald Exterior Acrylic Latex or similar. We recommend this same product if you wish to paint



your garage door. Do not use oil-based paints or spray paint on your kit.



OPTIONAL: You may wish to complete your kit by caulking along the edges of the molding where they meet the surface of your garage door. We recommend that you do this prior to painting and use a paintable caulk that is specifically designed for outdoor use.


